Official Rules

- **NO PURCHASE IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. A PURCHASE OF ANY KIND DOES NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING.**
- **VOID IN ALASKA, HAWAII, AND WHERE PROHIBITED BY LAW.**
- **ALL DISPUTES WILL BE RESOLVED SOLELY BY BINDING ARBITRATION AND ENTRANTS WAIVE THE ABILITY TO BRING CLAIMS IN A CLASS ACTION FORMAT.**

BY ENTERING (OR OTHERWISE PARTICIPATING IN) THE PROMOTION, YOU AGREE TO THESE OFFICIAL RULES, WHICH ARE A BINDING CONTRACT, SO READ THEM CAREFULLY BEFORE ENTERING. WITHOUT LIMITATION, THIS CONTRACT INCLUDES INDEMNITIES TO THE PROMOTION PARTIES FROM YOU AND A LIMITATION OF YOUR RIGHTS AND REMEDIES.

1. **ELIGIBILITY:** The FOX & Friends For All America Camper Giveaway 2026 (“**Promotion**”) is open only to legal residents of the forty-eight (48) contiguous United States and the District of Columbia, who are eighteen (18) years of age (19 in Alabama and Nebraska) or older as of date of entry. Residents of Alaska and Hawaii are not eligible to participate in the Promotion. Employees, officers and directors of Fox News Network, LLC (“**Sponsor**”), Realtime Media LLC (“**Administrator**”), Fox Corporation, Camping World, CSG Premier, and each of their respective parent companies, affiliates, subsidiaries, suppliers, vendors, contractors, distributors, sales representatives, advertising and promotion agencies involved in the Promotion (collectively, the “**Promotion Parties**”), and their immediate family members and those living in the same household as such individuals (whether legally related or not) are not eligible to participate in the Promotion or win the prize. For purposes of this Promotion, immediate family members are defined as spouse, partner, parents, legal guardians, in-laws, grandparents, siblings, children and grandchildren and their respective spouses, and those living in the same household shall mean people who share the same residence at least three (3) months a year, whether legally related or not. In the event that a household, based on address, enters the Promotion using more than five (5) unique email addresses, all of the Promotion entries associated with that household (determined by Sponsor or Administrator at their sole discretion) will be disqualified. Void where prohibited by law. All federal, state, and local laws and regulations apply. By participating in the Promotion, each entrant unconditionally accepts and agrees to comply with and abide by these “Official Rules” and the decisions of Sponsor, including the interpretation of these Official Rules, administration of the Promotion, selection of the winner, and Sponsor’s exercise of discretion, which will be final, non-appealable, and binding in all respects.
2. **TIMING:** The Promotion is comprised of three (3) separate phases, each consisting of independent drawings, each drawing with its own entry method, winner selection, and prize, as set forth herein.

The “**Registration Phase**” during which entrants register online and select, via a dropdown menu, one (1) in-person event location they would like to attend: Texas (TX), Kansas (KS), Florida (FL), Georgia (GA), South Carolina (SC), or New Jersey (NJ). From among all eligible entries received for each respective event location, three hundred (300) entrants will be selected for the Texas (TX) event, and one hundred fifty (150) entrants will be selected for each of the Kansas (KS), Florida (FL), Georgia (GA), South Carolina (SC), and New Jersey (NJ) events, in separate random drawings, to attend the selected event (each, an “**Event Invitation**”). Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to select additional entrants for any event location based on capacity, demand, or other logistical considerations.

The “**Event Phase**,” during which individuals selected during the Registration Phase will attend the applicable in-person event (each, an “**Event**”). At each Event, attendees will have the opportunity to enter on-site for a chance to win a trip to New York City (the “**Trip Prize**”). One (1) potential winner per Event will be selected in a random drawing from among all eligible on-site entries received at such Event to receive a Trip Prize and advance for a chance to win the Grand Prize (as further defined herein).

The “**Grand Prize Phase**,” during which the six (6) winners selected during the Event Phase will attend a live event in New York City, where one (1) Grand Prize winner will be selected for the opportunity to win a Camper (the “**Grand Prize**”).

The Registration Phase, Event Phase, and Grand Prize Phase (and all times in between phases) will collectively be defined as the “**Promotion Period**”. The designated computer clock of the Administrator is the official time-keeping device in the Promotion.

The Registration Phase is scheduled to begin on 12:00 p.m. Eastern Time (“ET”) on April 3, 2026, and end at 11:59 p.m. ET on June 3, 2026, and is comprised of six (6) separate events (each, an “**Event**”) each with its own entry period corresponding to a local event (each, an “**Event Entry Period**”) as set forth below:

The Event Phase is comprised of the six (6) Events and will occur on-site at the Event location, as set forth below. Events will be televised live as part of FOX & Friends programming.

The Grand Prize Phase will occur on July 3, 2026.

3. REGISTRATION PHASE ENTRY AND WINNER SELECTION:

A. How To Enter: During the Event Entry Period for your desired event, visit <https://CamperGiveaway2026.com> (“**Website**”) and follow the instructions on the Website to complete and submit an official entry form with all required information, including your full name, complete street address (no PO Boxes), email address, phone number, birth date, your guest’s first and last name, your guest’s email address, and select the one (1) Event from the drop-down menu. By submitting a completed entry form during the Registration Phase, you will receive one (1) entry into the applicable Event’s random drawing, subject to the limit below.

The Promotion Parties are not responsible for technical difficulties of any kind, or for false, incorrect, changed, incomplete or illegible contact information.

LIMIT: One (1) entry per person during the entire Registration Phase. Attempts made by the same individual to earn more than one (1) entry by using multiple or false contact information, accounts or otherwise may result in disqualification. All entries must be received by the end of the applicable Event Entry Period in order to participate. Entries generated by artificial intelligence,

script, computer programs, macro, programmed, robotic or other automated means are void and may be disqualified. Entries that are in excess of the stated limit, incomplete, illegible, corrupted, damaged, destroyed, forged, false, lost, late or misdirected, deceptive, or otherwise not in compliance with the Official Rules may be disqualified from the Promotion at Sponsor's sole and absolute discretion. Those who do not provide the required information in their entry form or abide by these Official Rules or other instructions of Sponsor may be disqualified, as determined by Sponsor or Administrator in their sole discretion. Entries submitted by individuals who do not meet the eligibility requirements (including all requirements with respect to age and residence) are void and may be disqualified by Sponsor or Administrator. In the event of a dispute over the identity of an entrant, entry will be deemed to have been submitted by the registered account holder of the email address associated with such entry, provided that person is eligible. Any potential winner may be required to show proof of being the registered account holder of such email address. Registered account holder is defined as the person assigned to an email address by an Internet access provider, online service provider, or other organization responsible for assigning email addresses. In the event that a dispute regarding the identity of the individual who submitted an entry cannot be resolved to Sponsor's satisfaction, the affected entry will be deemed ineligible.

- B. Event Entry Period Drawings:** On or about each of the Event Entry Period Random Drawing Dates set forth in Section 2 of these Official Rules, the Administrator is scheduled to conduct a random drawing from among all eligible entries received in accordance with these Official Rules for the applicable Event (each, an "Event Entry Period Drawing") to select potential entrants to receive an Event Invitation. Three hundred (300) potential entrants will be selected for the Texas (TX) Event, and one hundred fifty (150) potential entrants will be selected for each of the Kansas (KS), Florida (FL), Georgia (GA), South Carolina (SC), and New Jersey (NJ) Events, subject to Sponsor's right to select more or fewer entrants in its sole discretion based on capacity, demand, or other logistical considerations.
- C. Odds:** The odds of being selected to receive an Event Invitation depend on the total number of eligible entries received for the applicable Event during the corresponding Event Entry Period.
- D. Notification and Claiming of Event Invitations:** Each potential entrant selected to receive an Event Invitation will be notified via email using the information provided on the entry form in a commercially reasonable time after the applicable Event Entry Period Drawing. The email notification will include claim instructions, which must be followed in order to attend the Event. The Sweepstakes Parties are not responsible for and shall not be liable for incorrect, changed, or illegible contact information or for electronic communications that are undeliverable as a result of any form of active or passive filtering, or insufficient space in an entrant's email or other account to receive messages. The Sweepstakes Parties are not responsible for late, lost, intercepted, misdirected, or unsuccessful efforts to notify a potential entrant. Notification is deemed to have occurred immediately upon the sending of an email. If any notification is returned as rejected, faulty, unclaimed, or returned as undeliverable to a potential entrant; or if a potential entrant cannot be contacted within a reasonable time period, and/or is ineligible or otherwise fails to fully comply with these Official Rules, such potential entrant will be disqualified and an alternate will be selected at random from among all remaining eligible entries, time permitting, after which the Event Invitation will remain unawarded. A potential entrant becomes a "winner" only after verification of eligibility by Sponsor.
- E. Event Invitations; Restrictions:** Each Event Invitation consists of two (2) tickets to attend the applicable Event, to be used by the selected entrant and the guest identified on the entrant's registration form. Event tickets are non-transferable and may only be used by the selected entrant and their designated guest. Entrants should take this into consideration prior to submitting an entry. Food and hospitality will be provided at the Event. Event Invitations have no retail value and are not considered prizes. The number of Event Invitations available for each Event will be determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion and may vary based on capacity, demand, or other logistical considerations.

By attending an Event, the selected entrant and their guest agree to be filmed, recorded, and otherwise participate in audio, visual, and/or audiovisual recording in connection with the Event. All attendees (if a guest is a minor in his/her jurisdiction of residence, such minor's parent/legal guardian) will be required to sign a broadcast and publicity release ("**Broadcast Release**") on-site at the Event. Failure or refusal to sign the Broadcast Release may result in denial of entry to, or removal from, the Event. Sponsor is not responsible if any Event is delayed, postponed, or canceled for any reason. Event tickets are issued to the selected entrant only and may not be transferred to any other individual. The Event venue operations management or other associated representative reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to remove or deny entry to the selected entrant and/or guest if either engages in inappropriate, illegal, unsafe, or otherwise disruptive behavior, or with intent to create an unauthorized disturbance or interruption, or to otherwise annoy, abuse, threaten, or harass any other person at any Event. Limit of one (1) Event Invitation per person.

4. EVENT PHASE ENTRY AND WINNER SELECTION:

- A. How To Enter:** At the Event, individuals who received an Event Invitation and their guests (if guest meets the eligibility requirements set forth in these Official Rules and signs all applicable documents required to enter the Event) may enter for a chance to win a Trip Prize by completing the official entry form available on-site at the Event from Event staff. Entrants must follow all instructions provided by Event staff and must provide their full name, email address, and phone number on the official entry form. **Limit one (1) entry per Event.** Attempts made by the same individual to earn more than one (1) entry by using multiple or false contact information, accounts or otherwise may result in disqualification. All entries must be received by the posted end time specific to the Event in order to participate. Entries that are in excess of the stated limit, incomplete, illegible, damaged, destroyed, forged, false, lost, late or misdirected, deceptive, or otherwise not in compliance with the Official Rules may be disqualified from the Promotion at Sponsor's sole and absolute discretion. Those who do not provide the required information in their entry form or abide by these Official Rules or other instructions of Sponsor may be disqualified, as determined by Sponsor or Administrator in their sole discretion. Entries submitted by individuals who do not meet the eligibility requirements (including all requirements with respect to age and residence) are void and may be disqualified by Sponsor or Administrator.
- B. Trip Prize Random Drawings:** At each Event, after the posted end time, the Sponsor will conduct a random drawing to select one (1) potential Trip Prize winner from among all eligible entries received in accordance with these Official Rules at the applicable Event (each, a "**Trip Prize Random Drawing**").
- C. Odds:** The odds of winning a Trip Prize depends on the total number of eligible entries received at the applicable Event, based on the total number of attendees.
- D. Trip Prize Winner Notification/Trip Prize Claiming:** Each potential Trip Prize winner will be announced live at the Event at the completion of the Trip Prize Random Drawing. The potential Trip Prize winner must verbally announce their presence, indicating their plan to accept the Trip Prize. As part of the winner notification process, each potential Trip Prize winner will be required to sign a declaration of eligibility/release of liability/prize acceptance agreement and, where lawful, a publicity release ("**Declaration**") within three (3) days of date of Administrator sending via email, as a condition of receiving the Trip Prize. In the event of a conflict between the terms and conditions of the Declaration and the terms and conditions hereunder, the terms and conditions of the Declaration shall govern and control. If a potential Trip Prize winner should, prior to or during the Promotion Period commit any act which is antithetical to Sponsor or its products or services or which brings potential Trip Prize Winner or Sponsor into public disrepute or scandal, or which shocks, insults or offends a substantial portion or group of the community or reflects unfavorably on potential Trip Prize Winner or Sponsor, or in the event potential Trip Prize Winner engages in any behavior that Sponsor, in its sole discretion, finds to be obnoxious, threatening or otherwise

objectionable or that is intended to annoy, abuse, threaten or harass any other person, Sponsor may, in addition to and without prejudice to any other remedy of any kind or nature set forth herein or otherwise available, terminate the potential Trip Prize Winner's participation in the Promotion early, in whole or in part, and send the potential Trip Prize Winner home with no further compensation. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, potential Trip Prize Winner shall refrain from publicly making any disparaging or unfavorable comments about Sponsor or its products or services both during and after the Promotion. Further, during potential Trip Prize Winner participation in the Promotion and any Promotion-related activities, potential Trip Prize Winner may not (a) carry weapons of any kind (including, without limitation, firearms and knives); (b) use illegal drugs or prescription medication without a valid prescription; and/or (c) consume more than a reasonable amount (as determined by Sponsor in its discretion) of alcoholic beverages. If a potential Trip Prize winner fails to verbally announce their presence at the Event; if any Declaration is returned as rejected, faulty, unclaimed, or returned as undeliverable to a potential Trip Prize winner, or if a potential Trip Prize winner fails or refuses to sign the Declaration or accept the Trip Prize, and/or a potential Trip Prize winner is ineligible or otherwise fails to fully comply with these Official Rules; such potential Trip Prize winner will be disqualified and an alternate will be selected at random from among all remaining eligible entries received at the applicable Event, time permitting, up to three (3) alternates, after which the Trip Prize will remain un-awarded. A potential winner becomes a "winner" only after verification of eligibility by Sponsor. No more than one (1) Trip Prize will be awarded per Event. If, for any reason, more bona fide winners come forward seeking to claim a Trip Prize, the applicable Trip Prize winner may be selected in a random drawing from among all persons making purportedly valid claims. Inclusion in such drawing shall be each entrant's sole and exclusive remedy under such circumstances

E. Trip Prizes/Prize Conditions and Restrictions:

4 selected by Sponsor (on the same itinerary); two (2) nights standard hotel accommodation for the Trip Prize winner and guest (single room/double occupancy) at a Sponsor-selected hotel in New York City; roundtrip airport transfers while in New York; Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00 USD) made payable to the Trip Prize winner which may be used towards meals and other travel expenses while participating in the Trip Prize; One Thousand One Hundred Twenty-Five and Dollars (\$1,125.00 USD) made payable to the Trip Prize winner to help offset, but not eliminate, any tax obligation associated with Trip Prize acceptance; and the opportunity for the Trip Prize winner to participate in a Grand Prize award event televised on July 3, 2026 for the chance to win the Grand Prize. The approximate retail value ("ARV") of each Trip Prize is \$4,325. The actual value a Trip Prize may vary depending on the point of departure, fluctuations in the cost of air transportation, and fluctuations in the cost of hotel accommodation. Any difference between the ARV and the actual value of a Trip Prize will not be awarded. Sponsor's designee will contact each Trip Prize winner to arrange travel booking upon winner verification. If a Trip Prize winner resides within a 250-mile radius of New York City, as determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion, ground transportation may be provided in lieu of air transportation, and no compensation will be provided for any difference in Trip Prize value. The ARV of the Trip Prize if ground transportation is provided in lieu of air transportation, is \$3,125.

Travel must be taken on dates specified by Sponsor and is expected to be July 2 – July 4, 2026. If the Trip Prize Winner cannot travel on these dates, the Trip Prize Winner will forfeit the prize and an alternate winner may be selected as set forth in these Official Rules, if practicable. Each Trip Prize winner and their guest must travel on the same itinerary. Trip Prize winners and guests are responsible for having valid travel documents including a REAL ID or other government-issued identification approved for air travel. All airline tickets are subject to flight variation, work stoppages, and schedule or route changes. Sponsor reserves the right to structure travel routes, select hotels, and all other aspects of a Trip Prize in their sole and absolute discretion. Each Trip Prize winner is responsible for all travel expenses not included herein, including airline baggage fees, gratuities, meals, and any other incidental costs or expenses related to participation

in the prize. In the event a Trip Prize winner elects to take part in the prize without a guest, no additional compensation will be awarded in lieu of the unused Trip Prize components. Once a guest is selected, they may not be substituted, except in Sponsor's sole and absolute discretion. A guest must be eighteen (18) years of age or older as of date of travel. Each guest must sign and return a travel liability and publicity release before travel will be booked, and the Trip Prize winner agrees to cause the guest to sign such document and return it to Sponsor or Administrator promptly. Each Trip Prize winner and guest hereby acknowledge that Sponsor has not and will not obtain or provide travel insurance or any other form of insurance for any part of a Trip Prize. No changes will be made to travel details once any element of the travel arrangements have been booked, except at Sponsor's sole discretion. Each Trip Prize winner will be required to provide a major credit card upon hotel check-in, and all in-room charges will be charged to the credit card. Any damage to the room will be the responsibility of the Trip Prize winner. Sponsor bears no responsibility if any event, element, or detail of a Trip Prize is canceled, postponed, or becomes unavailable for any reason whatsoever by the air carriers, hotels, venue operators, transportation companies, prize providers or any other persons providing any prize-related services or accommodations. Sponsor is not liable for any missed Trip Prize events, or expenses incurred as a consequence of flight cancellation/delay or ground transportation delay. No refund or compensation will be made in the event of the cancellation or delay of any transportation or other Trip Prize element except at the sole and absolute discretion of Sponsor. Should any event, element, or detail of a Trip Prize become unavailable, the Sponsor shall have no obligation to the winner aside from providing the remaining portion of the Trip Prize, minus any unavailable event, element, or detail. The Sponsor reserves the right in its sole discretion to remove or to deny entry to the winner and/or guest if either the winner or guest violates the previous restrictions or engages in an obnoxious, inappropriate, illegal, unsafe, or otherwise disruptive manner, or with intent to create an unauthorized disturbance or interruption, or to otherwise annoy, abuse, threaten or harass any other person at any Trip Prize-related event.

The total ARV of all Trip Prizes available in the Event Phase is up to \$24,750.

5. GRAND PRIZE PHASE ENTRY AND WINNER DETERMINATION:

- A. Grand Prize Event Participation and Winner Determination:** On July 3, 2026, each Trip Prize winner will be provided with instructions to attend a televised Grand Prize event. Each Trip Prize winner will provide the services requested by Sponsor in connection with the Grand Prize event and shall continue rendering such services for the Promotion Period (unless eliminated prior to the expiration of the Promotion Period), and for such additional period or periods, if any, as shall be necessary to complete all services required of Trip Prize winner by Sponsor in connection with the Grand Prize Event or the Promotion at times and on dates determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion, time being of the essence. Trip Prize winner may be required to render services during post-production as, when and where requested by Sponsor for reshoots, added scenes, retakes, looping, dubbing and any other post-production services required by Sponsor. Each Trip Prize winner acknowledges and agrees that his or her participation is voluntary and is subject to Trip Prize winner being physically and legally able and willing to travel. The activities that are a part of the Grand Prize event are subject to change. In the event Trip Prize winner is unable or unwilling to participate in an event on the date(s) and at the time(s) requested, Contestant acknowledges that Trip Prize winner will forfeit the opportunity to participate or continue participating in the Grand Prize Event, and no other or additional compensation will be awarded. Trip Prize winner understands that in the event that the Grand Prize event does not or cannot take place, in whole or in part, as scheduled or at all, for reasons including but not limited to scheduling conflicts, cancellations, postponement, an event of "Force Majeure" (as defined herein), or for any other reason, then in lieu of participating (or continuing to participate, as the case may be) in the Grand Prize Event, Trip Prize winner will be invited to participate in the unaffected part(s) of the Grand Prize event, if any, which shall constitute full satisfaction of Sponsor's obligation to Trip Prize winner, and no other or additional compensation will be awarded.

Each Trip Prize winner must follow all of the Sponsor's directions. At the Grand Prize event, each Trip Prize winner will be provided with a key fob by Sponsor's representatives at random. Each Trip Prize winner will have the opportunity to attempt to unlock the Camping World Camper Van using their randomly assigned key fob. The Trip Prize winner whose key fob unlocks the Camping World Camper Van will be the Grand Prize winner, subject to verification.

- B. Grand Prize Event Appearance:** Trip Prize winner agrees that Sponsor or its designee may film, photograph and otherwise record Trip Prize winner's name, voice, likeness, appearance, actions, conversations and characteristics/mannerisms throughout the entire Promotion (collectively, the **"Appearance"**). Trip Prize winner should assume that all actions and statements of Trip Prize winner during Trip Prize winner's participation in Promotion-related activities are being recorded at all times. Trip Prize winner hereby specifically agrees and consents to such filming. Trip Prize winner hereby agrees to grant Sponsor access to any place, to the extent within Trip Prize winner's control, and to cooperate fully with Sponsor in obtaining access to any places Trip Prize winner may go during the Promotion that are outside of Trip Prize winner's control. Trip Prize winner agrees to refrain from patronizing businesses or seeking refuge in places where Sponsor's cameras and/or production crew are not allowed access. Trip Prize winner further agrees to cooperate fully with Sponsor in obtaining access to, and if necessary, releases from, other persons involved with Trip Prize winner, including but not limited to Trip Prize winner's guest, parents, siblings, boyfriend/girlfriend and friends. This is a non-union Agreement. Trip Prize winner acknowledges and agrees that the production of the Appearance hereunder shall not be subject to the terms of any collective bargaining agreement. If and to the extent this Agreement is or becomes subject to any guild, union or other collective bargaining agreement, then each entrant agrees that all union or guild fees that may be required in excess of any prize awarded hereunder shall accrue and be paid at the applicable union or guild minimum scale amount for such services.

The Appearance and all of the other results and proceeds of Trip Prize winner's activities in connection with the Promotion, including without limitation any and all still photographs or video that Trip Prize winner shoots in the course of performing his or her Promotion activities (collectively, the **"Results and Proceeds"**) shall be deemed a work-made-for-hire for Sponsor specially ordered and/or commissioned by Sponsor for use in an audio-visual work, and therefore, Sponsor shall be the author and exclusive copyright owner thereof for all purposes throughout the universe. If under applicable law the foregoing is not effective to place authorship and ownership of the Appearance and the Results and Proceeds and all rights therein in Sponsor, then by way of assignment and transfer of present and future copyright and otherwise, each Trip Prize winner hereby irrevocably grants, transfers, sells and assigns to Sponsor, all right, title and interest therein.
